## Proverbs 3:9-10 (ESV)

Honor the LORD with your wealth and with the firstfruits of all your produce; <sup>10</sup> then your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will be bursting with wine.

(Prov 3:9-10).

Money functions paradoxically:

selfishness yields suffering  
(Prov 11:24-25).

## Proverbs 11:24-25 (ESV)

One gives freely, yet grows all the richer;  
another withholds what he should give, and  
only suffers want. <sup>25</sup> Whoever brings blessing  
will be enriched, and one who waters will  
himself be watered.

## Proverbs 19:17 (ESV)

Whoever is generous to the poor lends to the LORD, and he will repay him for his deed.

God is intimately involved when  
we give (Prov 19:17).

## Proverbs 26:13 (ESV)

The sluggard says, “There is a lion in the road! There is a lion in the streets!”

Stop making excuses  
(Prov 26:13).
