## Ephesians 4:31-32(ESV)

Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. <sup>32</sup> Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving <u>ONE</u> <u>ANOTHER</u>, as God in Christ forgave you.



- a. Is not dependent on an apology
- b. Does not equal reconciliation

- d. Is not a feeling




- e. Is not always a one-time event

- i. Choosing not to forgive does not increase your protection
- j. Choosing not to forgive does not mean the other person is being punished

## Luke 17:5-6 (ESV)

The apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith!" <sup>6</sup> And the Lord said, "If you had faith like a grain of mustard seed, you could say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you."

- b. Fear of confrontation (rebuke)
- c. Pride (repent)
- d. Misunderstandings about forgiveness

### Luke 17:7-10 (ESV)

"Will any one of you who has a servant plowing or keeping sheep say to him when he has come in from the field, 'Come at once and recline at table'? 8 Will he not rather say to him, 'Prepare supper for me, and dress properly, and serve me while I eat and drink, and afterward you will eat and drink'?"



<sup>9</sup> "Does he thank the servant because he did what was commanded? <sup>10</sup> So you also, when you have done all that you were commanded, say, 'We are unworthy servants; we have only done what was our duty."
