GC Discussion Questions

Big Idea: *Our cleansing by the sacrificial Savior exemplifies the attitudes and actions of all God's people*

1. Before reading the text: Do you remember a time that someone served you in a memorable way? What made this act of service significant to you?
2. After reading the text: Today we come to the famous “foot washing” passage. According to the text, what reasons are given for Jesus washing his disciples’ feet? (Consider v. 1, 8, 14-15)
3. According to our text, what should be the source or motivation for Christian service? How does verse 16 fit into this?
4. Jesus does not send Judas out until after he has washed his feet. What implications does this have for us today in serving others?
5. It is impossible to be a servant if we are self-focused. Are there areas in your life where self-absorption is hindering your ability to serve others? How do we become a person who looks “not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others” (Phil. 2:4)?
6. Take some time to evaluate Church on Mill. Do we do a good job of displaying the love of Christ by serving one another? What are some practical ways we can better follow the example of Christ in service?
