Sermon Title: Jesus Overcomes Sermon Text: John 16:25-33



## GC Discussion Questions

Big Idea: Because Jesus has overcome, his imperfect disciples have a loving relationship with the Father and an unconquerable peace amidst all kinds of trials.

- 1. When was the last time that something took away your peace? How did you go about trying to restore your peace?
- 2. In verses 25-27 Jesus talks about the time following his resurrection. According to Jesus, how will things be different from before his death and resurrection?
- 3. The disciples are convinced that their faith in Jesus is fully mature (v. 30). What reason does Jesus give for questioning the integrity of the disciples' faith (v. 31-32)?
- 4. Although the disciples will scatter in fear, Jesus says he will restore them to peace. What will be the source of the disciples' peace?
- 5. Jesus does not promise to take away our difficult circumstances—in fact, he promises that difficult circumstances are sure to come (v. 33)! What are some trials you are currently facing, and how can this passage bring you peace?
- 6. Spend some time reflecting on the glorious truths that the Father loves us and hears us, and that Jesus has ultimately conquered every form of evil in the world. Pray for Jesus' peace to be with individuals, and with Church on Mill as a whole.
