## GC Discussion Questions

***Big Idea: As promised, King Jesus rose again in victory, appeared to many, and prepared his disciples for his ascension and their continuance of his gospel mission.***

1. Have you ever told a true story that someone didn't believe? In a situation like that, how did you go about persuading them that it was a true story?
2. Let's read John 20:1-31.
3. Do you think that any of these people in John 20 expected Jesus to rise from the dead? How do you think that you would have responded if you were in that same situation?
4. What is the main purpose of this chapter in the book of John?
5. What are the three primary sets of evidence that John gives to prove that the resurrection actually happened?
6. What does each set of evidence mean for our own life? In other words, what unique hope does each of these "witnesses" of the resurrection give to us?
7. In light of all this hope that we have, what role does the resurrection play in establishing and fulfilling the mission of the church?
8. What are ways that you currently experience the hope of the resurrection at Church on Mill? What are ways that we can encourage other members of Church on Mill to live in that hope? How can Church on Mill grow in faithfulness to testify about the facts of the resurrection to our neighborhood?
