Family Ministries

Preschool Serve with children under 6 by teaching, assisting, or greeting.

Children Teach elementary school a pre-assigned curriculum.

Youth Co-teach Middle School or High School a pre-assigned curriculum.

Worship Gathering Ministries

Audio Mix the sound of the band and ensure microphones are ready.

Media Shout Prepare and run Powerpoint slides.

Music Play the drums, bass, electric guitar, acoustic guitar, piano, or sing.

Connection Classes Teach or apprentice in adult classes.

Usher Distribute bulletins and coordinate those who take the offering.

Fellowship Team Ministries

Greeting Welcome guests and direct them as needed.

Hospitality Facilitate fellowship between gatherings with food and comfort.

Clean-Up Crew Reset materials, Bibles, and pick up between gatherings.

Coffee Bar Make espresso drinks and be a friendly face.

International Lunches Prepare lunch for international students.
