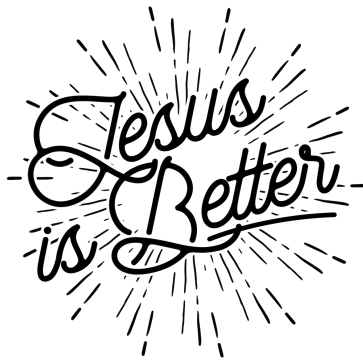
A PRAYER ABOUT MONEY
