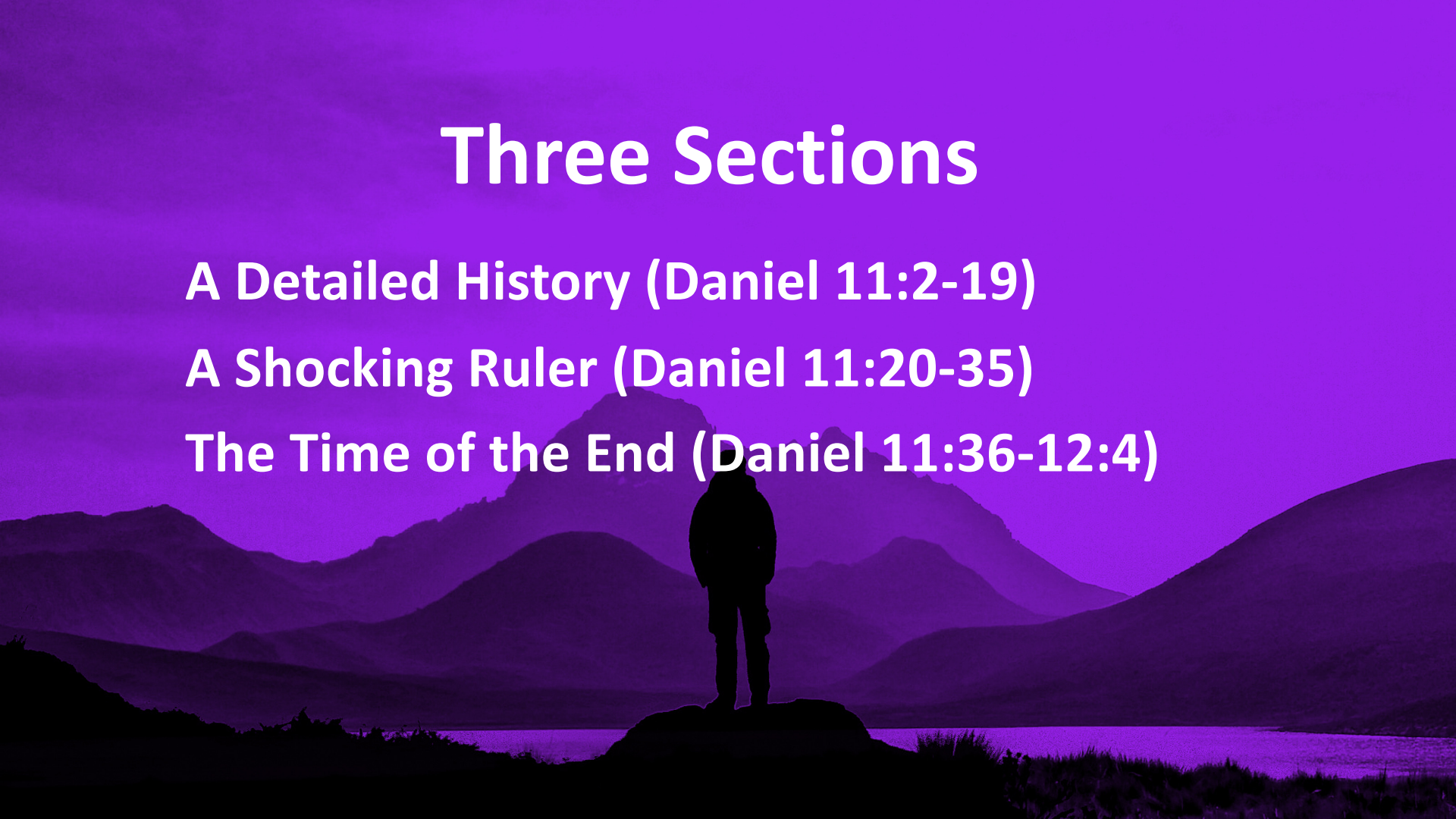



## Dan 11:2-4 (ESV)

“And now I will show you the truth. Behold, three more kings shall arise in Persia, and a fourth shall be far richer than all of them. And when he has become strong through his riches, he shall stir up all against the kingdom of Greece.

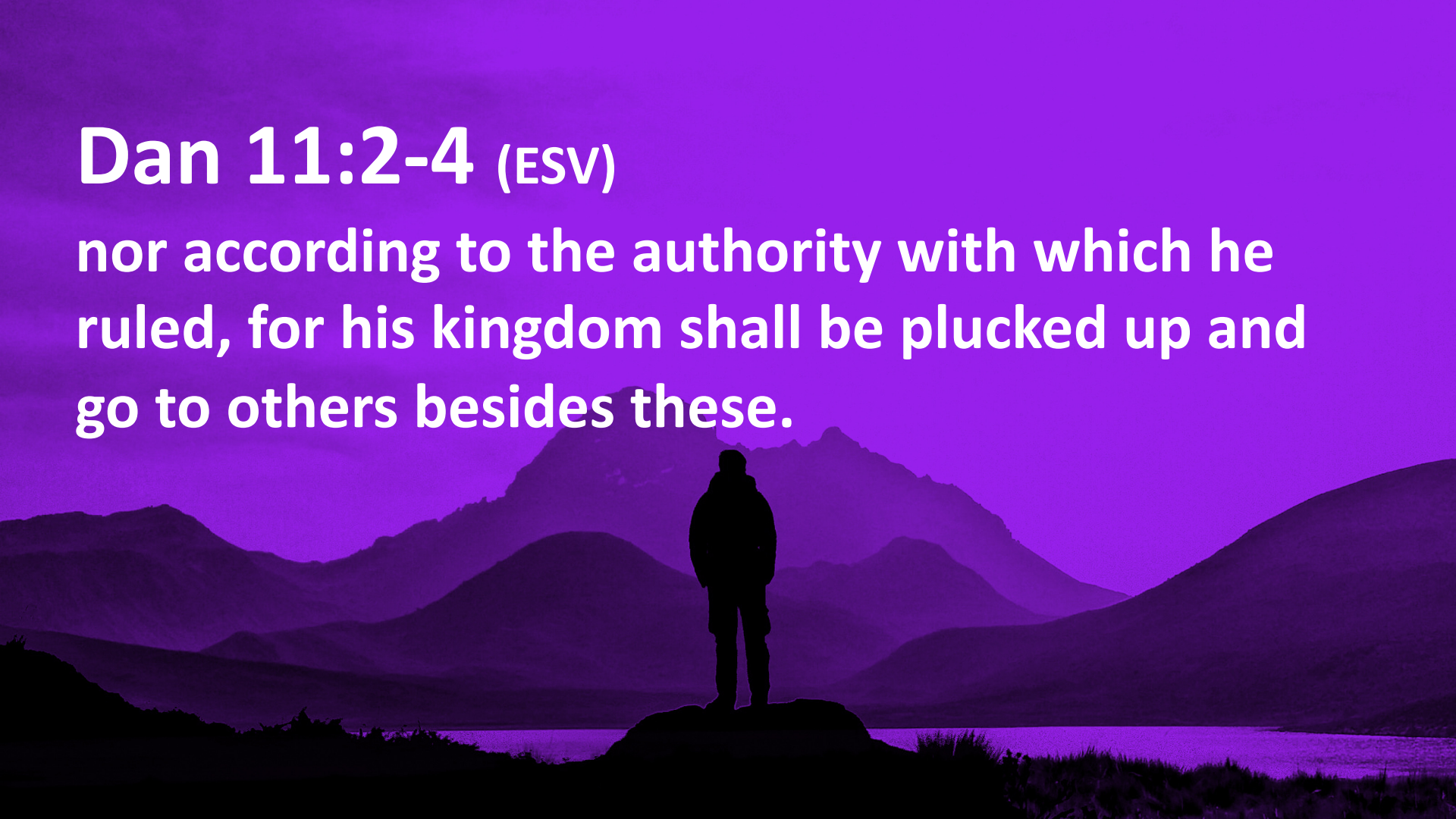
# Dan 11:2-4 (ESV)

# Dan 11:29-30a (ESV)

“At the time appointed he shall return and come into the south, but it shall not be this time as it was before. <sup>30a</sup> For ships of Kittim shall come against him, and he shall be afraid and withdraw,



# **Dan 11:30b-31 (ESV)**

**and shall turn back and be enraged and take action against the holy covenant. He shall turn back and pay attention to those who forsake the holy covenant.**



# Dan 11:30b-31 (ESV)

<sup>31</sup> Forces from him shall appear and profane the temple and fortress and shall take away the regular burnt offering. And they shall set up the abomination that makes desolate.

and some of the wise shall stumble, so that they may be refined, purified, and made white, until the time of the end, for it still awaits the appointed time.




## **Dan 11:36-45 (ESV)**

**“And the king shall do as he wills. He shall exalt himself and magnify himself above every god, and shall speak astonishing things against the God of gods. He shall prosper till the indignation is accomplished; for what is decreed shall be done.**


# Dan 11:36-45 (ESV)

<sup>37</sup> He shall pay no attention to the gods of his fathers, or to the one beloved by women. He shall not pay attention to any other god, for he shall magnify himself above all. <sup>38</sup> He shall honor the god of fortresses instead of these.

# Dan 11:36-45 (ESV)




## **Dan 11:36-45 (ESV)**

Children, it is the last hour, and as you have heard that antichrist is coming, so now many antichrists have come. Therefore we know that it is the last hour.




# Dan 12:1-4 (ESV)


