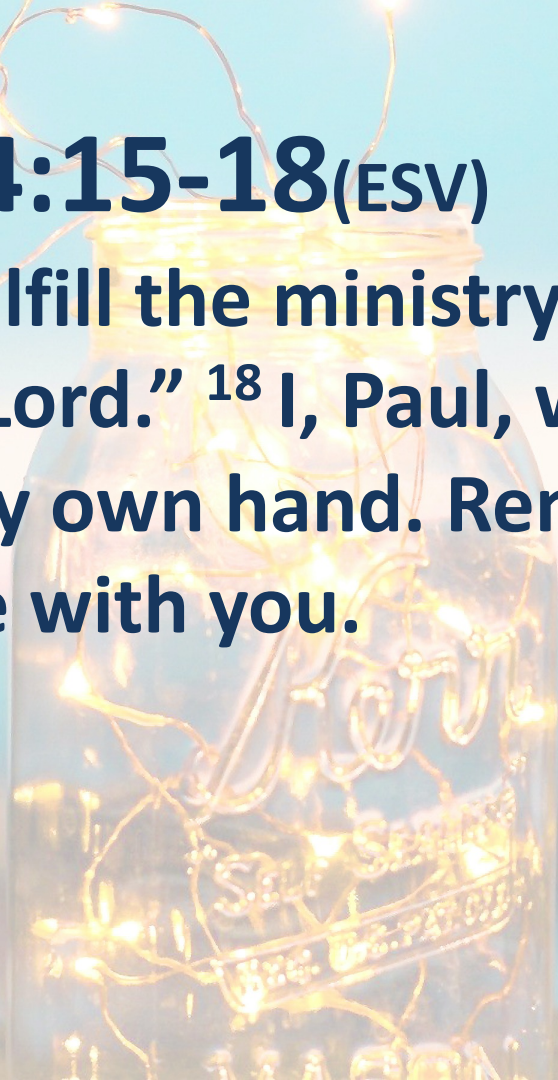
## **Colossians 4:15-18(ESV)**
