Ecclesiastes 11:9 (ESV) ⁹ Rejoice, O young man, in your youth, and let your heart cheer you in the days of your youth. Walk in the ways of your heart and the sight of your eyes. But know that for all these things God will bring you into judgment. ¹⁰ Remove vexation from your

Ecclesiastes 12:2-5 (ESV)

² before the sun and the light and the moon and the stars are darkened and the clouds return after the rain, ³ in the day when the keepers of the house tremble, and the strong men are bent, and the grinders cease because they are few, and

Ecclesiastes 12:2-5 (ESV) those who look through the windows are dimmed, ⁴ and the doors on the street are shut—when the sound of the grinding is low, and one rises up at the sound of a bird, and all the daughters of song are brought low—⁵ they are afraid also of

Ecclesiastes 12:2-5 (ESV)

what is high, and terrors are in the way; the almond tree blossoms, the grasshopper drags itself along, and desire fails, because man is going to his eternal home, and the mourners go about the streets—

Decay will haunt you long before death catches you.

Ecclesiastes 12:6-8 (ESV)

⁶ before the silver cord is snapped, or the golden bowl is broken, or the pitcher is shattered at the fountain, or the wheel broken at the cistern, ⁷ and the dust returns to the earth as it was, and the spirit returns to God who gave it. ⁸ Vanity of vanities,

Ecclesiastes 12:6-8 (ESV) says the Preacher; all is vanity.

If Christ redeems you from death, He will redeem you from decay as well.
