

One Day in Capernaum



Mark 1:21-22 (ESV)

²¹ And they went into Capernaum, and immediately on the Sabbath he entered the synagogue and was teaching. 22 And they were astonished at his teaching, for he taught them as one who had authority, and not as the scribes.

Jesus has authority over doctrine.

Mark 1:23-28 (ESV)

²³ And immediately there was in their synagogue a man with an unclean spirit. And he cried out, 24 "What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God." 25 But Jesus rebuked

him, saying, "Be silent, and come out of him!" 26 And the unclean spirit, convulsing him and crying out with a loud voice, came out of him. 27 And they were all amazed, so that they questioned among themselves, saying, "What is this? A new teaching with

authority! He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey him." ²⁸ And at once his fame spread everywhere throughout all the surrounding region of Galilee.

Jesus has authority over demons.

Mark 1:29-34 (ESV)

²⁹ And immediately he left the synagogue and entered the house of Simon and Andrew, with James and John. 30 Now Simon's mother-in-law lay ill with a fever, and immediately they told him about her. 31 And he came and took her by the hand

Mark 1:29-34 (ESV)

and lifted her up, and the fever left her, and she began to serve them. ³² That evening at sundown they brought to him all who were sick or oppressed by demons.

33 And the whole city was gathered together at the door. 34 And he healed

Mark 1:29-34 (ESV)

many who were sick with various diseases, and cast out many demons. And he would not permit the demons to speak, because they knew him.

Jesus has authority over disease.

Jesus has authority over doctrine, demons, and disease.
